The proposed academic programme will include 3-hour interactive seminars with a focus on practical topics to be demonstrated through case studies and project-based approach. Seminar instructors will be industry professionals who will incorporate their real-world perspective and industry experts into the curriculum.

PROPOSED ACTIVITIES

Welcome Ceremony and Breakfast, Orientation, and Campus Tour

The Baruch College Continuing and Professional Studies staff will welcome the group from the Warsaw University of Technology Business School and provide an orientation for the program and introduce students to the Baruch campus. Breakfast will be included.

Business Site Visits

Students will participate in faculty-guided site visits to companies in New York City that will correspond to their seminar topics. Students will participate in one site visit with a marketing focus and a second site visit with an entrepreneurship focus.

Entrepreneurship Panel Discussion with Business Owners and Select Start-Ups & Networking

Along with other business students from the Baruch College community, students will participate in a panel discussion on the topic of entrepreneurship presented by select business owners and start-ups followed by a networking session.

NYC World Trade Week Event

Students will have the opportunity to participate in an event during the annual New York City World Trade Week that occurs during the month of May each year. World Trade Week is a collaboration of more than 40 New York City organizations to promote and underscore the importance of international trade, logistics, and port operations that are fundamental to the economy of the region.

Other New York City Events (optional, self-funded)

In New York City there is a large variety of professional, cultural, and other types of events open to the public that are hosted by different kinds of organizations from non-profits to large corporations. These events feature prominent figures speaking about interesting topics related to their work. Some events







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are free and others have a small fee. Closer to the program start date, we will provide a list of events that will be happening during the program that students can participate in.

Circle Line Cruise around the Island of Manhattan (optional, self-funded)

Students have the option to participate in a guided evening cruise around the island of Manhattan where they can see and learn about some of New York City's major landmarks.

Broadway Show (optional, self-funded)

Students have the option to attend one of New York City's famous Broadway theatre shows.

Program Completion & Farewell Lunch

During the program completion ceremony, students will receive their program completion certificates and have the opportunity to celebrate their achievements with program staff. Lunch will be included.

More precise details about the content and scheduling of the proposed activities will be provided closer to the program start date and as schedules of outside events become available.
